TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR KGTML TERMINAL OPERATING SYSTEM (TOS)

DEFINITIONS

- **User:** Any transport company, shipping company, consignee, shipper, agent, or entity submitting vehicle or cargo registration information to the TOS.
- **TOS:** Terminal Operating System managed by Karachi Gateway Terminal Multipurpose (Private) Limited (KGTML) for processing logistical and operational data.
- Access Credentials: User-specific login credentials used to access the TOS.

GENERAL USER ACCESS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Users must register with KGTML and obtain prior authorization before accessing the TOS.
- Users are strictly prohibited from sharing their login credentials with unauthorized parties.
- KGTML reserves the right to deactivate access in case of:
 - Multiple or unauthorized logins
 - Unauthorized data extraction
 - Misuse of the system
- Users are responsible for the confidentiality of their account credentials and for ensuring that all vehicles or operations comply with KGTML's safety, security and operational standards.
- Misuse or submission of fraudulent data may result in suspension, termination, or legal action.
- Users must comply with all applicable local laws and regulations.

CATEGORIES OF USERS

A. SHIPPING COMPANIES

1. Introduction

These terms govern registration and operational requests submitted by shipping companies using the TOS. Use of the TOS implies acceptance of these terms.

2. User Access and Responsibilities

- Submit accurate and complete information.
- Ensure the submitter is authorized to act on behalf of the company.
- KGTML reserves the right to approve, reject, or seek clarification on any submission.
- Retain original versions of all uploaded documents and images.

3. Submission Authorization

Submission authorizes KGTML to execute the requested operations.

 Submissions do not impose any enforceable obligation on KGTML unless explicitly approved.

4. Miscellaneous

- KGTML may request additional supporting documentation.
- Repeated misuse may result in access suspension.

B. CONSIGNEES AND SHIPPERS

1. Introduction

These terms apply to consignees and shippers interacting with TOS for cargo-related transactions.

2. User Access and Responsibilities

- Provide and maintain accurate, updated information.
- Ensure accountability for nominated C&F agents and transporters.
- Utilize the TOS for booking, payments, and documentation purposes.

3. Submission Authorization

- Submission authorizes KGTML to process and act upon the requested operations.
- Direct usage (without nominating third parties) implies acceptance of applicable terms and responsibilities.

4. Miscellaneous

- Retain originals of all submitted documents.
- Submissions are subject to KGTML's final approval.

C. CLEARING & FORWARDING (C&F) AGENTS

1. Introduction

These terms apply to C&F agents acting on behalf of clients via TOS.

2. User Access and Responsibilities

- Process delivery-related documentation and formalities.
- Nominate authorized transporters as necessary.
- Ensure appropriate conduct of all associated representatives.

3. Submission Authorization

- Authorized to nominate drivers/agents and manage documentation.
- Submissions must be backed by retained original documents.
- Each request is subject to individual approval by KGTML.

4. Miscellaneous

• If the C&F agent uses self-transportation, they become fully subject to the Transporter Terms.

D. TRANSPORT COMPANIES

1. Introduction

These terms govern transporter registration and truck data submission via TOS.

2. User Access and Responsibilities

- Submit authorized truck and driver details.
- Cooperate with RFID/MTag installation and inspection processes.
- Consent to lawful sharing of submitted data with regulatory bodies.
- Notify KGTML of any operational or personnel changes.

3. Submission Authorization

- Responsible for legal compliance of vehicles and staff.
- Any damaged, missing, or tampered RFID tags must be reported.
- KGTML reserves the right to deny access or require further verification.

4. Miscellaneous

- Ensure full compliance with QHSE standards, legal norms, and documentation requirements.
- Misuse or submission of false information may result in penalties or legal action.

E. TERMINAL USERS (INTERNAL AND VENDORS)

1. Introduction

This section governs KGTML staff, contractors, and vendors using TOS.

2. User Access and Responsibilities

- Follow all SOPs, contractual agreements, and work instructions.
- Ensure that staff are legally authorized, trained, and compliant with safety and security standards.
- Use only approved hardware, devices, and software within the terminal.

3. Confidentiality and Security

- Maintain strict control over login credentials.
- Refrain from unauthorized access, device manipulation, or software tampering.
- Immediately report any staff discontinuation to KGTML for credential deactivation.

DATA PRIVACY AND SECURITY

- KGTML employs reasonable data protection protocols but shall not be held liable for breaches caused by user negligence.
- Data submitted through TOS may be disclosed to regulatory authorities as required by law.
- Users expressly consent to the collection, storage, and processing of their data in accordance with KGTML's privacy policies.

LIABILITY AND DISCLAIMERS

- The TOS is provided "as is" without warranties, express or implied.
- KGTML shall not be held liable for any errors, omissions, or interruptions in the TOS.
- Users agree to indemnify and hold KGTML harmless from claims arising due to inaccurate data or non-compliance.
- Access may be suspended temporarily for maintenance or in case of unforeseen technical issues.

TERMINATION AND MODIFICATIONS

- KGTML reserves the right to modify these Terms and Conditions at any time without prior notice. Continued use of TOS constitutes acceptance of the modified terms.
- KGTML may terminate or suspend user access at its discretion, without notice, in case of misuse or policy violation.
- Users may voluntarily terminate access by submitting a written request to KGTML.

GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of Pakistan.
- Any disputes arising shall first be resolved through mediation. Failing that, disputes shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration Act of Pakistan.
